

How to determine your ring size

The String Method

- 1: Cut a piece of string, ribbon or thread long enough to wind around the ring finger with a little left over.
- 2: Wrap it around your finger so it's snug, but not so tight it wouldn't fit around your knuckle. The best way to make sure is to fit it on the area just below the knuckle.
- 3: With a felt tip marker, make a mark on the string where it overlapped.
- 4: Use that length to measure against the chart below to determine your size.

The Paper Method

- 1: Download and cut out the paper strip pictured below.
- 2: Cut along the dotted line that says "Find your size" to make a slit.
- 3: Slip the pointed end through the slip and place it around your finger.
- 4: The arrow will point to your ring size.

The Secret Method

Don't want that "special someone" know?

- 1: Print our chart of ring size circles below.
- 2: Find a ring that your loved one currently wears.
- 3: Make sure he or she wears that ring on the finger you are shopping for.
- 4: Place the ring on top of each circle until you find the perfect match.
- 5: Double check for accuracy.
